



HOCKEY HALL OF FAME ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENTS TO THE SELECTION COMMITTEE

TORONTO (November 15, 2022) – **Lanny McDonald**, Chair of the Board of the Hockey Hall of Fame, announced today appointments to the Hockey Hall of Fame Selection Committee as confirmed at the Directors’ meeting held yesterday in Toronto.

Scott Morrison will join the eighteen-member Selection Committee commencing with the 2023 nomination and election proceedings, replacing **Michael Farber** who served his full-term limit of 15 years. Morrison is the recipient of the 2006 Elmer Ferguson Memorial Award in recognition of members of the hockey-writing profession whose words have brought honour to journalism and to hockey. Among his many contributions to the game, he served as President of the Professional Hockey Writers’ Association from 1987 to 1993.

“I wish to express our appreciation and gratitude to Michael for his long-time distinguished service and outstanding contributions and I am also very pleased to welcome Scott to the Selection Committee,” said McDonald. “Scott is one of the most respected hockey journalists whose coverage of the game with major media organizations since the 1980’s speaks volumes to his recognition as a Hockey Hall of Fame Media Honouree. We look forward to his insights as part of the Selection Committee’s deliberations continuing its mandate of honouring excellence in our game.”

In addition to the new appointment, **Cassie-Campbell Pascall**, **Mark Chipman**, **Ron Francis**, **Jari Kurri** and **Bob McKenzie** were re-appointed to the Selection Committee each for a further three-year term expiring December 31, 2025, while **Steve Dryden**, having recently retired as Senior Managing Editor of Hockey for TSN and former Editor in Chief of The Hockey News, was appointed as **Director, Statistical Analysis and Data Services** to provide resources for members of the Selection Committee in making the most informed nominations on eligible player candidates.

The Selection Committee will meet on **June 21 & 22, 2023** to consider duly nominated candidates for election into Honoured Membership. The announcement of the new inductees will be made on **June 22, 2023** and the annual Induction Celebration will be held on **Monday, November 13, 2023**.

The Hockey Hall of Fame (“HHOF”) was established in 1943 to honour and memorialize individuals who have brought special distinction to the game of hockey and those who made outstanding contributions to the development and advancement of hockey anywhere in the world, and to collect, research, preserve, exhibit and promote objects, images and other historical materials connected with the game at all levels. As a not-for-profit corporation and registered charity, HHOF owns and operates a museum and place of entertainment offering state-of-the-art exhibits, theatrical presentations and educational programming from its premises at Brookfield Place, Toronto, and a multi-purpose archive, resource centre and research facility located at 400 Kipling Avenue, Toronto.
